COACHES INFORMATION

Home/Away - Jerseys

- Teams are asked to provide a **DARK** colour jersey (**home**) and a **LIGHT** colour jersey (**away**) for each game. *White* is preferable for the light jersey.
- The first team listed on the draw will be considered the home team for the games
- The same format will continue in the playoffs. The higher seeded teams will be given the home designation.

First Aid/Athletic Therapy

- Teams must bring their own medical supplies and plan to do their own taping. Any pre-existing injuries are to be dealt with by the individual, parent, medical professional, or coach prior to games.
- Athletic therapists will be on site to assist with any injuries that occur during the tournament.

Equipment

- Flags and belts will be provided for every team to use during play
- Teams are allowed to bring their own game footballs (to be used on offense)
 - a. Game balls will be checked by the officials during the equipment check
 - b. Approved brands and sizes are below:

Wilson Brand - Youth Size: *Composite or Leather* materials

Nike Brand - Youth Size: *Tournament or Championship* models

Rouge Brand - CF 14 Size: *Composite or Leather* materials

Also: If available, the newly approved IFAF **Wilson REVO** footballs are also allowed

Dressing Rooms

- Due to the number of teams playing during each time slot (up to 8 teams at a time), change rooms will not be assigned to specific teams and will be general use for all teams. Players and staff should not leave equipment or personal belongings (especially valuables) in the dressing rooms and all items should be brought with teams to their sideline during the game.

GRIEVANCE & DISCIPLINE

- A disciplinary committee shall be formed for the tournament consisting of a member of School Sport Alberta, Football Alberta and the Referee in Chief for the tournament.

Grievances can be submitted to this committee for consideration and disciplinary actions as they relate to participation in the tournament can be enforced at the discretion of the disciplinary committee.

All decisions by the disciplinary committee will be considered final with no ability to appeal made available.

SPECTATOR INFORMATION

SSA Code of Conduct

Spectators, both student and adult, must demonstrate courtesy and good sportsmanship by positive cheers of encouragement for their team, not against the opposing team. This is evidenced by the absence of booing and vulgarities. Spectators must also show proper acceptance of officials' judgment.

Artificial noisemakers are not permitted during provincial championship tournaments/events. These noisemakers may include but are not limited to: air horns, cowbells, plastic tube horns, garbage can lids, etc. The provincial championship host shall have the authority to eject from the competition facility individuals who, following a warning, refuse to comply with this requirement.

The Executive Committee or its host/designated representative shall have the authority to direct any person to immediately leave any premises or venue hosting any SSA-sanctioned event if that person:

1. Exhibits rude or abusive
2. Uses vulgar, obscene or abusive language and/or gestures;
3. Fails to promptly follow any reasonable direction given to that person by the designated representative of the SSA

Food & Beverage

- A concession stand will operate on site during tournament hours organized by Spruce Grove and District Minor Football Association

EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN
